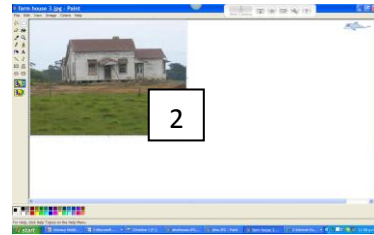


# How to mix and edit photos in MS Paint

1. Open **TWO** copies of the MS Paint programme.
2. In **one** open your background photo. Make sure it's the right size for the images you add to it. **TIP > You can easily resize images by bringing them into in MSWord. Then copy and paste.**



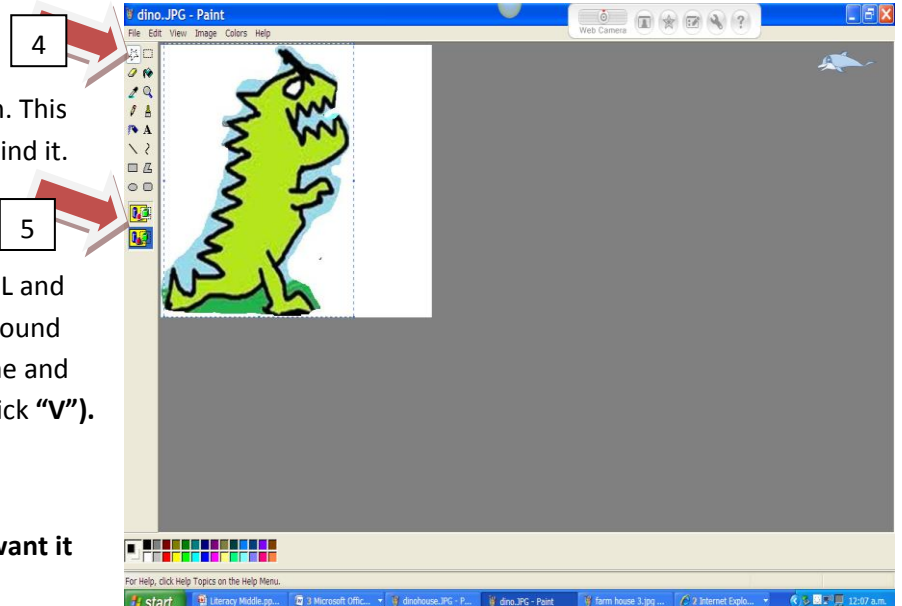
3. Open the image you want to **CUT** in the second Paint programme.
4. Click the freehand select tool on the tool bar. Cut carefully around the image.

**While STILL SELECTED...**

5. Click the "Select Opaque" Button. This allows backgrounds to be seen behind it.

6. **COPY** the image (Hold down CTRL and click "C"). Then swop to the background image in the other Paint programme and **PASTE** it in (Hold down CTRL and click "V").

7. Place the image wherever you want it over the background.



The same technique can be used to place heads on bodies, or place students in strange places and countries etc.
